## Return to Play Guidelines: Adult 6v6 Soccer

- MCPR will communicate policies and guidelines to the soccer supervisors and players.
- MCPR will provide soccer supervisors and players with sanitizing products.
- MCPR will communicate immediately with the local health department in the event of a confirmed COVID-19 case within a team and cancel all of the games for that team and any team they have played in the past two weeks.
- MCPR will schedule games so that one team/group can conclude and depart prior to the next team/group arriving avoiding high traffic times.
- MCPR will establish designated parking areas for the different teams based on their field assignment.

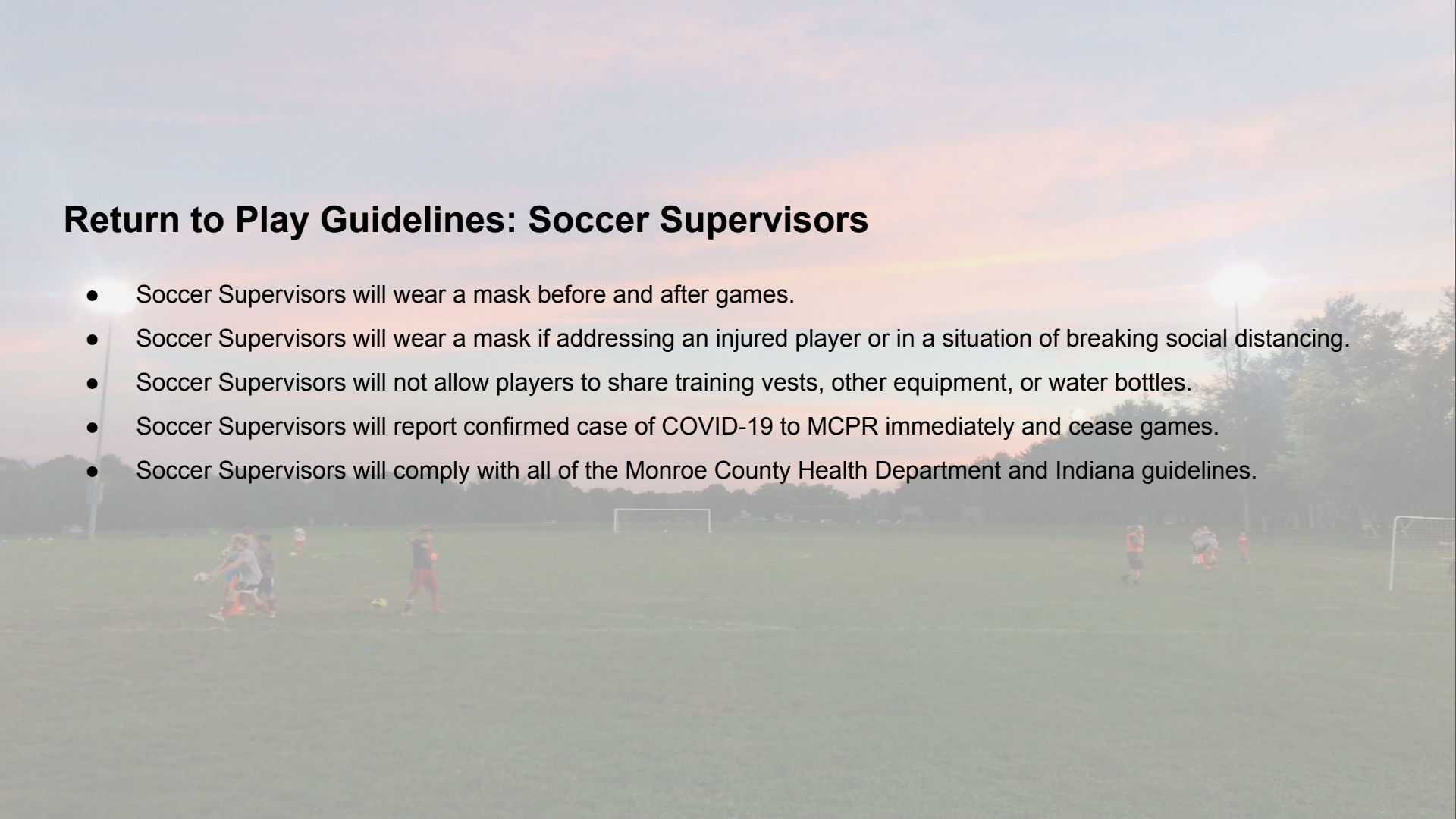
## Return to Play Guidelines: Players


- Players with fever, cough, or other symptoms of respiratory illness are not permitted to play in the games.
- Players that have family members with fever, cough, or other symptoms of respiratory illness are not permitted to play in the games.
- Players are recommended to use hand sanitizer before and after games.
- Players must bring their own ball to games.
- Players must bring their own drink to games. No sharing.
- Players should sanitize their soccer ball before and after games with household disinfectant or soap and water.
- Players are recommended not to carpool to and from games.
- Players are recommended to wear masks before and after games.
- Players are recommended to wear gloves during games.
- Players are recommended to wash all clothing items promptly after games.



## Return to Play Guidelines: Soccer Supervisors

- Soccer Supervisors will wear a mask before and after games.
- Soccer Supervisors will wear a mask if addressing an injured player or in a situation of breaking social distancing.
- Soccer Supervisors will not allow players to share training vests, other equipment, or water bottles.
- Soccer Supervisors will report confirmed case of COVID-19 to MCPR immediately and cease games.
- Soccer Supervisors will comply with all of the Monroe County Health Department and Indiana guidelines.
